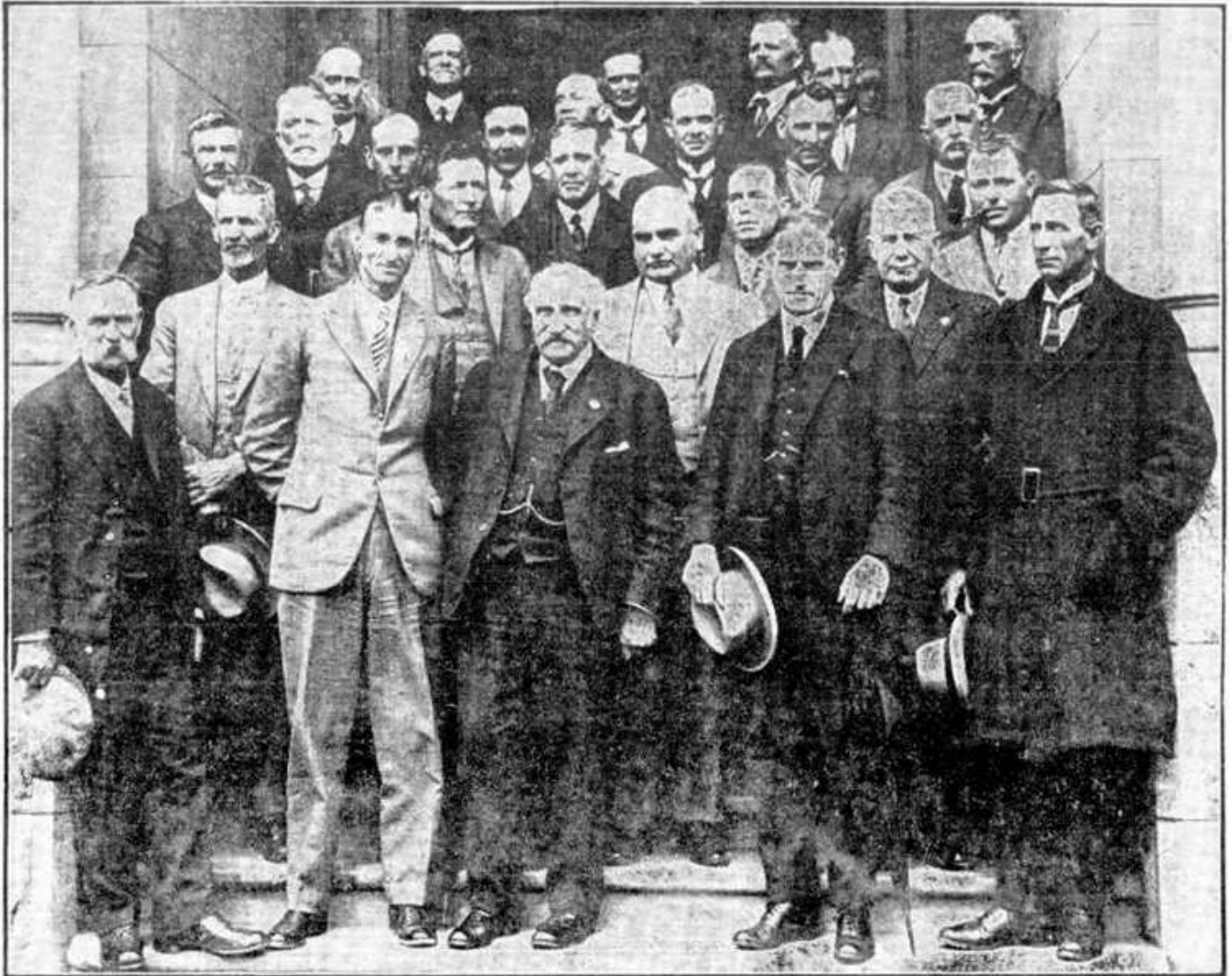

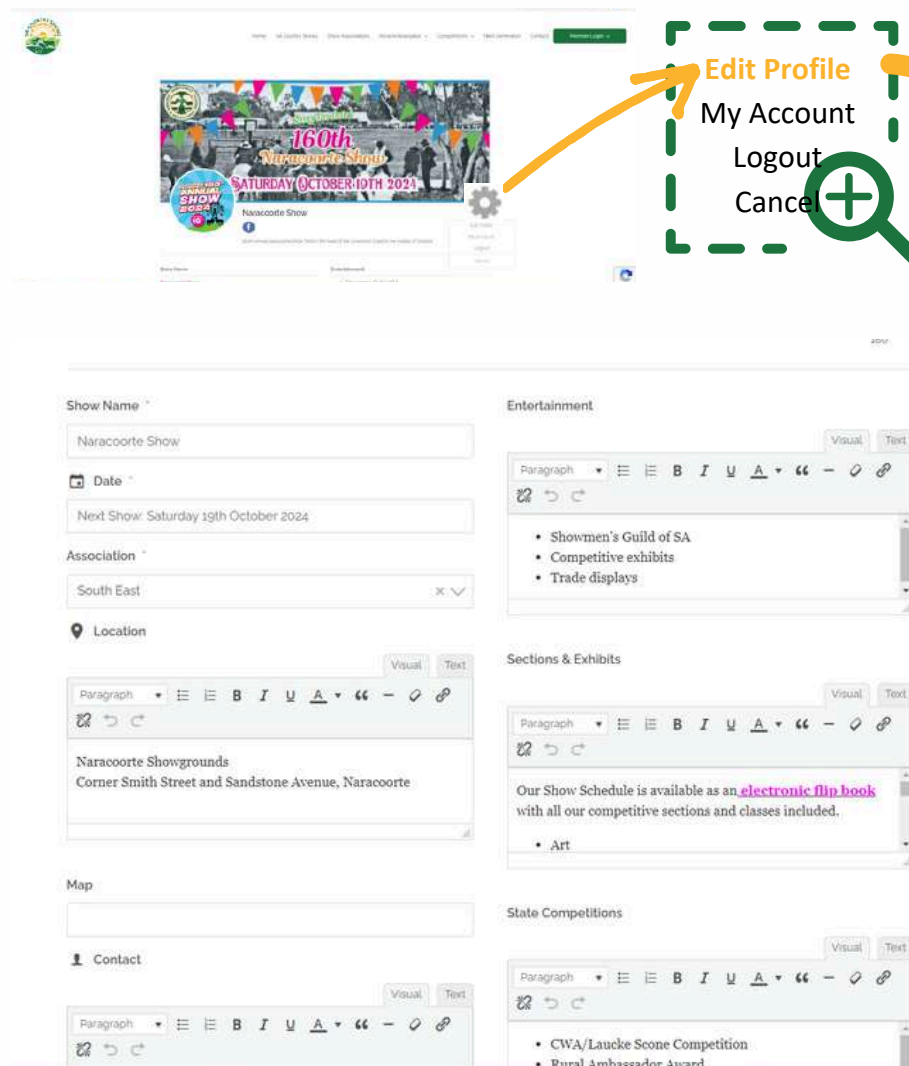




# WEBSITE TIPS FOR SACOUNTRYSHOWS.COM

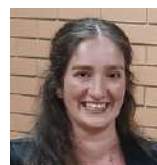
