Elsie is completing Year 12 at Walford Anglican School and aspires to undertake an Agricultural Science degree with elements of marketing and business. She participates in dance and is completing a Certificate 4 in Dance Teaching and Studio Management. Elsie volunteers weekly in the school OSHC program, connecting with the younger students. She enjoys attending country shows, entering cookery and participating in young judges and paraders competitions including sheep and poultry.

Representing the Karoonda Show, Matilda Baumgurtel, from the Murray Lands was runnerup, recognised for her art and baking entries at local shows, her work as a tutor and a grain classifier for Viterra last summer and for her focus on sustainable farming practices.

The Young Rural Ambassador Award, supported by the Department of Primary Industries and Regions South Australia (PIRSA), has been run by SA Country Shows for 25 years. The award recognises the contribution young adults in rural and regional South Australia make to agricultural shows. It also acknowledges the importance of strong youth participation to the agricultural show movement.

Competing provides excellent opportunities for participants to express their views, advance their communication and networking skills and develop closer links with rural communities in South Australia. The awards have become a valuable succession process for South Australia's country shows with entrants often assuming leadership roles within their respective show societies, communities and within agricultural industries.
